Early Years Funding

As you may know, the government has introduced new Early Years funding to help families with the cost of childcare. We are delighted that more children will now have access to funded hours, which is such a positive step for early learning and for families.

However, we also want to be honest with you about what this means for nurseries. The funding we receive from the government does not fully cover the actual cost of delivering high -quality childcare. This includes staffing, resources, training, meals, and maintaining safe and stimulating environments for your children. Like many nurseries, we are facing increasing pressures with rising costs, and while we are committed to offering the best possible care, we have to carefully balance what the funding allows with the true costs of running our setting.

We want to reassure you that your children remain at the heart of everything we do. We are proud of the nurturing, enriching environment we provide, and we will continue to go above and beyond to support their development. At the same time, we ask for your understanding as we navigate these changes. It may mean that nurseries, including ours, need to review session structures, introduce small charges for extras, or limit funded hours to remain sustainable.

Most importantly, we want to thank you. Your trust, support, and partnership mean the world to us. By working together, we can continue to give your children the very best start in life.
